



Vigil Honor Nomination 2012

The Vigil Honor is a high mark of distinction and recognition reserved for those Arrowmen who, by reason of exceptional service, have made distinguished contributions beyond the immediate responsibilities of their position or office in scouting, while still remaining active in the Order of the Arrow. It is the highest honor that the Order of the Arrow can bestow upon its members for service to the lodge, the council, and Scouting. Vigil Honor candidates are selected by a committee of youth who have previously been honored with the Vigil Honor.

To be eligible to receive the Vigil Honor, an Arrowman must have been a Brotherhood member for at least two years at the time of the election. As such, only those who became Brotherhood members in 2009 or earlier are eligible for induction in 2012.
